Space Chase is this year's Summer Reading Challenge and Milton Keynes libraries are inviting children of all ages to take part.

We would like as many children as possible to read or have help reading any 6 library books of their choosing during the summer holidays. Along the way they receive stickers to put on their Space Chase card, there are six to collect. Stage one gets the Rockets get mission ready, stage 2 helps the Rockets locate missing books on an alien space ship and stage 3 sees them return the books to the Moon Library. As long as stocks last children will receive a medal and certificate upon completion of the challenge. It is free to join the library and participate in the Summer Reading Challenge. Last year Milton Keynes had nearly 3000 children participate.
