<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>⇒ Keep your speed slow</li><li>⇒ Park further away from school to reduce congestion</li><li>⇒ Always let your child out of the vehicle</li><li>⇒ Check for pedestrians and cyclists before opening the car door</li><li>⇒ Always set a good example for your child</li><li>⇒ Park in the designated spaces</li><li>⇒ Walk to school as much as possible</li><li>⇒ Be polite and courteous</li></ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"><li>◇ Block the road</li><li>◇ Park on the yellow zig-zag lines</li><li>◇ Park on the pavement, across dropped curbs or driveways</li><li>◇ Park opposite or within <b><u>10 metres</u></b> of a junction</li><li>◇ Park where you will cause an inconvenience to other road users</li><li>◇ Leave your vehicle with the engine running</li><li>◇ Stop in the middle of the road to drop your child off</li></ul>
