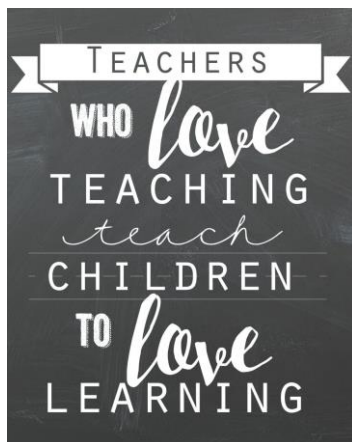


Dear Parents / Carers
