In this topic children will

Communication and Language:

This half term we will be exploring how we can help plants grow, what do animals need to grow and how can we help ourselves grow. Our new vocabulary will be Big, small, giant, tiny, huge, little, bigger smaller, biggest, smallest, growing, changing, planting, garden, cycle, watering, compost, seed, petals, stem, herbivore, carnivore, omnivore, prey, predator.

Reading:

We will be continuing to learn to retell stories using our own words and story language from the core texts.

We will be learning the next set of sounds for our group in the RWI phonics scheme & continue to develop blending skills to start to read simple CVC words. We will be practicing our segmenting skills to write simple VC/CVC words & e will focus on the red words he, she, you, like & said.

Writing

We will be looking closely at the settings and characters in our core texts. We will be really focusing on constructing simple sentences using the sounds we know.

We will also be finding information from non-fiction books to answer our questions about what do plants need to be able to grow and stay healthy. We will also look at safari animals and how the differ from animals we learnt about previously, which live in the Artic & Antarctic.

Physical Development:

We will be learning gymnastics using our equipment at school. We will be learning how to make different shapes with our bodies and explore how to move on equipment safely. We will also be reflecting on what foods help us grow big and strong.

Maths:

In maths we will continue to develop our understanding of numbers and begin to solve simple calculation problems through practical exploration with concrete objects and pictorial representation. We will explore shapes and arrangements (compose/ decompose) as well as introducing numerical patterns such as doubling, odds & evens.

This term our core value is **Respect**. We will thinking about how we show respect to everyone and linking this back to kindness. In our PSHE jigsaw lessons we will be discussing how we look after ourselves, how we keep ourselves clean, eating the right foods and why it is important to move our bodies.


Understanding of the World:
